- Vikings as traders, explorers, farmers, and warriors.



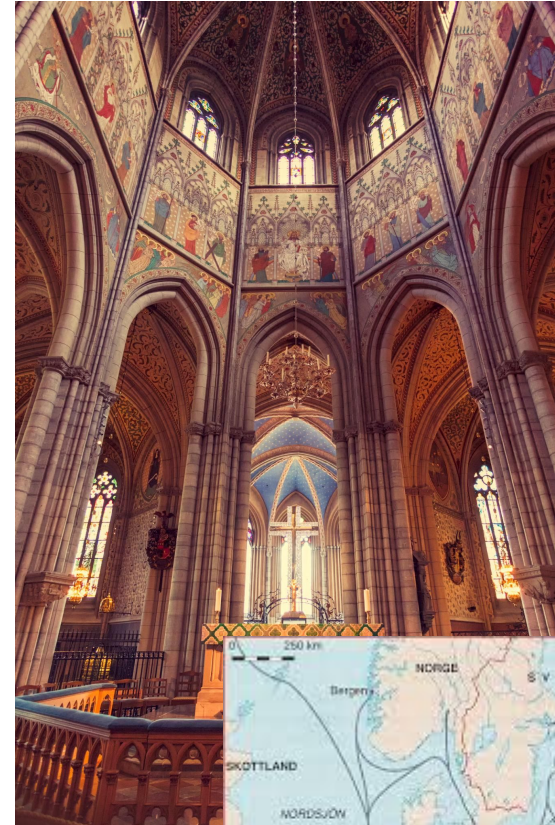
Swedish Traditions and Celebrations
